First laid out in 1674 on a gentle south-facing slope, formal walled gardens are set against a romantic medieval moat house (not open) These 17th Century Formal Gardens include a white rose garden, herbaceous borders, knot garden, nut walk, oriental garden, secret garden, a paradise walk plus drunken garden with crazy topiary and water sun dial.

The "Enchanted Forest", an ancient woodland, was developed by innovative designer, Ivan Hicks, introducing magic, mystery, history and romance. A canal boat trip to or from the forest gardens is available.

Weather permitting, birds of prey are flown from the Raptor Centre. There is also a Conan Doyle Museum.

A **pre-booked** one hour guided tour giving history and garden design of this unique formal garden is available (approx £1 extra per person) if there is sufficient interest.
